

COACHING

The NICA Coach Licensing Program is the most important program NICA manages to help grow youth cycling in NorCal. NICA coaches are the backbone of this movement. The NICA Coach License Program reflects our values; provides a physical activity-based positive youth development curriculum, training, and evaluation; and inspires volunteers - meeting their respective needs. The NorCal League provides NICA coach training on an ongoing, annual basis.

RACING

The NorCal League was the first high school cycling league in America. We continue to provide opportunities for NorCal teens to learn foundational life lessons, self-awareness, discipline, success, failure, fun, community, and graceful defeat. Racing helps teach student-athletes empathy for others, humility, flexibility, and adaptation to different personalities, cultures, and needs within the context of team. Athletes learn to overcome obstacles effectively, both on and off the bike, through racing in NorCal League races.

ADVENTURE

Our adventure program allows youth who aren't wired for competition to experience the benefits of mountain biking, camaraderie, community, advocacy, adventure and the outdoors.

NorCal adventure programs reinforce our core values while building health and strength, learning new skills, and being part of a team of like-minded people through outdoor experiential education.

GRIT

GRIT is NICA's focused effort to bring more girls into cycling, bridging the opportunity gap with future generations. Making space for girls to experience the benefits that come from challenging yourself and being part of a team, the GRIT program is an initiative executed at the league level with volunteer driven efforts to recruit more girls into all NorCal programs. You can't be what you don't see and NorCal aims to continue to increase female participation in our programs.

TEEN TRAIL CORPS

The Teen Trail Corps (TTC) program teaches youth a healthy respect for work, nature, and the importance of giving back through trail stewardship. Giving back to our community through bike related advocacy is an important activity that all recreational groups using outdoor resources have a responsibility to maintain. TTC gives youth an opportunity to participate in the work that goes on behind the scenes of a great trail.


